TO GET A FREE DOWNLOAD File OF SAMS SCHEMATICS/DATA FOLLOW THESE STEPS

1. FIRST YOU WILL NEED A HOUSTON LIBRARY CARD NUMBER AND CODE.
  - a. Fill out application at <http://houstonlibrary.org>. Must be a Texas resident.
2. After you get your card number (by email) , Log-In to Houston Library.
3. On the home page, go to “Research: A-Z databases” (blue arrow)
4. Scroll Venders to “SAMS PHOTOFACTS” (venders are alphabetical)
5. Sign-in again at Sams Site with your Library card number.
6. On the Search line put in Model number and/or Make/chassis. (blue arrow, below)
7. A list of Makes and Models that are similar will come up. Select the one you want.
8. Download the pdf file you want to your computer and print. Ignore the \$15 price line.
9. Sign Out, done
